# INTRODUCTION

Dear Colleague,

many thanks for your interest in the 4th European Communication Conference of the European Communication Research and Education Association (ECREA). In this brief guide you will find useful information that will guide you through the submission process of your panel proposal.

All panel proposals will be submitted at one central location, via the conference website at [www.ecrea2012istanbul.eu](http://www.ecrea2012istanbul.eu). Once the call is closed, these will be redistributed to each of the 17 Thematic Sections of ECREA for the blind peer-review process. As you will see in the next pages, you have to choose a specific section to which you want to submit your panel proposal. Please note that proposals cannot be submitted outside the sections.

You can submit more than one panel proposal, but please note that only one paper where each presenter is the first author will be accepted and programmed. However, presenters will still be able to be a second (or third, etc.) author of other papers or posters, as well as be able to act as chair or respondent of a panel. Please note that all panel submissions will require **5 participants**. Panels with less (or more) than 5 participants **will not be accepted**. **Important:** once you start the submission process you will need to submit the panel by the end of this process as the submission platform does not allow to save the proposal and submit it later.

English is the working language of ECREA, therefore proposals will need to be submitted in English. Please note that the call will close on **28 February 2012**. There will be no extension of the deadline. Early submissions are strongly encouraged as this will permit you to contact us, and have feedback, in good time before the expiry of the deadline in case any problem occurs.
